

CAVALRY:

*Horse owners **MUST** present a current and valid Coggins test certification upon registrations.

*Water will be provided. Bring your own feed.

GENERAL RULES, GUIDELINES AND REQUESTS:

***Campfires** - The park management has requested that you should have 2 pieces of burlap. One to put under the carefully removed sod and the other to lay over the top of the removed sod. It should be watered often. Each campfire should have a water bucket close by.

*Clean up your camp sites before you leave. ***Absolutely not trash or refuse is to be buried in the fire pits.***

*All participants, military and civilian, must dress in period style clothing and act in the manner appropriate for the era within the encampment during open camp hours. There will be NO non-period articles visible during open camp hours.

*Camp will be quiet at and after midnight on Friday and Saturday.

*Camp will close at 4pm on Sunday afternoon.

*Please interact appropriately and knowledgeably with the public.

*If you have a dog, they must be on a leash at all times. You must clean up after your dog as there is a fine for not doing so. Please be considerate of your neighbors during the weekend.

Please do not violate the above rules. We do not want to be put in a position to ask you to leave.

SUTLERS: A compliment of sutlers will be present.

Amenities: Flush toilets, sanitary portable units, pool and showers will be available in the park. You may bring your own food to prepare at your camp sites.

*Firewood will be available. ***Per Wisconsin Law, please do not bring your own.***

*Potable water will be provided.

*Breakfasts and lunches will be available at the park.
